

This program is available at **no cost** to approved families.


BENEFITS

FAQS

Q: Is the Project only appropriate for people in the early stages of the disease?

A: No, the Project has proven beneficial to people in every stage of the disease.

Q: Do I need a computer to participate?

A: No, we will set up and load your iPod with music, based on your selections during the application process.

Q: Are you able to provide language or culturally-specific music?

A: Yes! We use iTunes to purchase the music, and we have the ability to accommodate the all cultural and language-specific needs.

Q: Does the iPod recipient need to visit your office?

A: No. The application process and iPod pick-up is often done through a care partner.
