

CarePartner – AST First Mobile Application Supporting Caregivers

The Dementia Talk App is an award- winning mobile application that was designed to empower caregivers of people with dementia to manage care at home through tracking behaviours and creating care plans to address challenging situations they encounter. The app was created by the Reitman Centre at Mount Sinai Hospital and transferred to the Alzheimer Society of Toronto.

With a grant from the Ontario Trillium Fund, the Alzheimer Society of Toronto was able to build on the work of the Dementia Talk App and has now renamed it to the “Care Partner” application . It has tools and resources to support caregiver to someone living with dementia, ultimately promoting everyone’s well being.

The application includes features such as Behaviour Tracker, Behaviour Care plan, Scheduler and a Caregiver Corner with strategies to support the caregiver.

The application is scheduled for download in July 2023 on Google Play and the Apple store. The account can be deleted by using ‘Delete Account’ function in the app settings.

The Society has enhancements plans including adding tutorials on YouTube on the various features and other enhancements based on feedback received from its users.
